Since launching HYFIN on Juneteenth Day in 2022 our team has been busy tabling at community events, meeting with Black-owned businesses and building our listening audience. Our mission is to be a public media platform created by and for the Black community here in Milwaukee, playing the full spectrum of Black music and celebrating Black excellence. We are still working tirelessly to raise the necessary funds to meet the \$450,000 match required by our grant with the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.
