



Our Eligibility Requirements

- > 501(c)(3) organizations
- Operate in Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Washington or Waukesha County
- Annual revenue between \$500,000 and \$7 million for 3 most recent years. (Line 12 of 990)
- Filed an IRS Form 990 for 3 most recent years.
- Have three (3) years of independently prepared financial statements (audited or reviewed by a qualified CPA Firm).



And....

- ➤ Have <u>current licenses*</u> with the Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions – **both Corporate <u>AND</u> Charitable** at the time you submit your Letter of Inquiry. * Will need to submit proof of current licenses with your Letter of Inquiry.
- Submit only one Letter of Inquiry each year. An organization that has received our grant of \$100,000 may reapply after three full grant years.
- Expend the full grant amount within 24 months of the award.



Program or Project Requirements

- ➤ Be a capital project, new program, expansion of an existing program to be completed by the nonprofit alone or in collaboration with other nonprofit organizations.
- ➤ Target a specific population for a specific duration of time and have specific measurable goals.
- Visit website for items not eligible for funding.



What About Collaborations?

Only if this makes sense!

- A collaborative relationship is one between two or more nonprofit organizations that lowers costs and/or increases gains for those served by their programs.
- When two or more organizations collaborate, they align their missions and activities to achieve a common goal.
- ➤ A collaboration may also meaningfully change the way participating organizations do business for the long-term.
- Collaborating nonprofit must meet all Impact100MKE's eligibility requirements except for the annual revenue size.

Projects or programs that cultivate, develop, educate or enhance the artistic and/or cultural climate in the Greater Milwaukee area.



Education

Projects or programs that improve or advance educational opportunities for children and/or adults in the Greater Milwaukee area.



Environment & Revitalization

Projects or programs that (1) preserve, enhance or restore facilities, spaces or surroundings; (2) promote the protection and welfare of animals; or (3) encourage conservation in the Greater Milwaukee area.

Grant Focus Areas



Family

Projects or programs that strengthen or enhance the lives of children, adults and families living in the Greater Milwaukee area.



Health & Wellness

Projects or programs that positively impact the mental or physical health of people living in the Greater Milwaukee area.



Focus Area Ranking











Focus areas apply to the **project or program** – not necessarily to the overall mission of the organization.

Example: An organization operating a food pantry is considering a grant to develop a financial literacy program for the families it serves.




Grant Committees


